In years past, retirees and seniors looked forward to downsizing and perhaps living a life of leisure in a retirement community. Now, the trend has swung to people wanting to remain in their family homes.

By the year 2030, the U.S. population of those ages 65 and up will grow to approximately 17 million and an estimated 1 in 5 Americans will be 65 or older. But many homes aren't ready.

"Only 1% of homes in the United States are conducive to aging in place, however, more than 75% of older Americans want to stay in their homes for as long as possible," states the United Disabilities Services (UDS) Foundation.

"Older homes don't always meet the needs of older Americans," claims a U.S. Census Bureau in a report that reviews the number of homes containing aging-accessible features, along with households with older adults experiencing difficulty using some aspect of their home.

Although we're in better physical condition and tend to live longer than previous generations, we still have the normal challenges of aging, such as mobility and vision issues.

WHAT IS AGING IN PLACE?

Aging in Place is defined as planning to live in your own home and maintain an independent lifestyle throughout your later years rather than in assisted living or retirement community.

Homes can be modified or remodeled to incorporate Aging in Place features. They can also be built or added on to with adaptive features. This architectural trend is known as Universal Design, a specialty

that offers comfort and safety to all people without the need for functional changes or adaptation. Incorporating Universal Design principles into a remodel or construction project ensures that your future needs are taken into consideration during the design/build process.

WHAT ARE THE RISKS FOR **OLDER AMERICANS?**

More than 25% of adults over the age of 65 report trouble using a feature of their home. At age 85, that number increases to almost 50%. Steps and stairways are the most common problem areas, followed by bathrooms. "More than half of bathroom injuries are directly related to using the shower and getting in and out of the bathtub," claims the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). Installing simple fixes like handrails, grab bars and shower seats can help reduce this safety risk.

Approximately 30 million older Americans fall each year-about one fall each second of the day. And one in five of those falls result in serious injury, with direct medical costs totaling more than \$50 million annually. Seven million people have trouble living on their own, and almost four million have difficulty bathing or dressing themselves.

HOW CAN YOU MODIFY YOUR HOME FOR AGING IN PLACE?

Planning for your future is never easy because you don't know how your needs are going to change as you age. So how can you make your home easier to live in?

- Bathrooms: Add grab bars, curb-less shower entries, and comfort-height toilets to improve access and safety.
- **Stairs**: Add a ramp to outside entrances and perhaps a chair lift when stairs become difficult.
- **Lighting**: Ensure that lighting is brighter. Install motion-activated lights for

hallways, and lighted switches to make them easier to find.

Not all changes need to be made at once. They can be implemented gradually or as needs change. Some of the simpler adjustments you can make to your home can include:

- Handrails along indoor and outdoor steps
- Grab bars in showers and alongside toilets
- Anti-scald temperature controls
- Changing doorknobs to levers
- Automatic lights
- Removing small rugs that could be tripping hazards
- Ramps to outside entrances
- Nonskid flooring

OTHER ALTERATIONS **CAN INCLUDE:**

- Adjusting electrical outlets to an easier-to-reach height
- Widening doorways & hallways (36" minimum)
- Replacing a fold-down oven door with a double door side-opening oven
- Reconfiguring the kitchen by lowering the cooktop, and installing pull-out shelves in lower cabinets.

For more major changes like renovations or new construction, talk to a professional builder or design/build remodeler. Ask if that company has a Universal Design Professional Certified (UDCP) or other senior-specialist designer on staff. Someone with this specialized training can help you make the correct choices for your individual needs.




SOLVING BATHROOM PROB-LEMS FOR SENIORS


a lot of stuff getting in the way. Look for sturdy wall hooks and towel hangers that they can use to keep towels and bathrobes off the floor. The less clutter you have in the bathroom, the safer it will be for seniors to navigate.

Try a walk-in tub. Walk-in tubs and showers are best for seniors, since they prevent having to "climb over" the edge. These tubs are perfect for the elderly who want to age in place and prefer to live at home rather than in an assisted living facility.

Install grab bars. Grab bars on the shower and bathtub walls and next to the toilet will give your loved one something to hang onto if they feel dizzy or tired. These bars can be found at most home improvement stores and do an excellent job at providing seniors with some extra stability in the bathroom.

Check the dimensions. Seniors who use a wheelchair should have a bathroom door that's at least 34-inches wide. The inside of the bathroom should have a minimum of a five-foot radius so they can easily turn around. You should also ensure that there are at least 27 inches of clearance under the sink for the wheelchair. Hang mirrors low enough so that seniors don't have to strain or stand on their tiptoes in the bathroom.

Sógia Candles are about refined design coupled with a passion for the planet. Their motto is you don't have to sacrifice style to live a sustainable life and to create the perfect ambiance.

Each candle is handcrafted locally in Tysons Corner, Virginia. Sógia's tasteful eco-

friendly candles are made from reclaimed glass bottles filled with all-natural soy wax and organic hemp wicks, and come with a sustainable cork coaster. They are made in small batches and each candle is truly unique.

Sógia partners with local restaurants and bars like Sfizi in Falls Church, Nostos and Bonaroti in Vienna to collect bottles that would otherwise

be discarded, which are transformed into something naturally beautiful.

We sat down with the founder of Sógia Candles to find out more about the business.

WHY DID YOU START SÓGIA CANDLES?

After realizing that Fairfax County doesn't recycle glass any longer I felt bad about just trashing used glass items. Since the majority of the glass was wine and beer bottles I thought of a way to reuse them by making soy candles.

As it turns out, every year, more than 28 billion glass bottles and jars end up in landfills. It can take a glass bottle one million years to decompose in the environment, possibly even more if it's in a landfill. We know we're not going to make a significant dent but every little bit counts and a greener home-ware choice seemed like a good idea.

The great thing about our candles is they can be recycled even further. Soy wax is easily cleaned out with warm soapy water and our glass containers can be reused for all sorts of things...plant pots, pen holders, or we can refill it for another candle.

We also have an endless supply of containers—everyone is so kind to provide their empties.

WHY ARE SÓGIA CANDLES UNSCENTED?

Our candles are purposely unscented

are made from re-

claimed glass bottles

filled with all-natural

soy wax and organic

hemp wicks

because they're intended for use while dining and in the kitchen. We want the aromas of your food to be the focus of your enjoyment and the candles to provide the ambiance and atmosphere. There are so many candles out there but we didn't find many sustainable ones that were fragrance free.

Another, more personal reason, is an allergic reaction

to fragrance. I really enjoy candles but the severe headaches I get from scented candles is unbearable. I also thought it's the safest bet when buying a gift, you don't have to guess at someone's preference when you give an unscented candle.

WHY DID YOU CHOOSE 100% SOY WAX FOR YOUR CANDLES?

There are several reasons why we chose soy wax for our candle—primarily because it's an eco-friendly, renewable resource that's totally sustainable. After looking into the various wax types it's the best environmental choice. We all have to do our part to save the earth one day at a time and this seemed like a small way to start.

Also, soy candles burn cleanly with no petro-carbon soot. The 'black film' on jar candles is the soot emitted by paraffin wax which is a petroleum by-product. Toxins released from paraffin candles are the same as those found in diesel fuel fumes and are linked to asthma and lung cancer.

Environmentally, the impact of paraffin should also be mentioned—crude oil, the origin of paraffin wax, is highly unsustainable and a non-renewable resource. It's been the cause of many environmental issues as in oil spills, damage of natural habitats, and climate change.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF SOY WAX?

After looking into the various types of wax we decided on soy for the following reasons:

Sustainable/Eco-Friendly—Soy wax is derived from soy beans which are a natural, renewable resource. Our soy wax comes from US farms.

Biodegradable—Soy wax is biodegradable and environmentally friendly. It also cleans easily with soap and water.





PLANS DYNAMIC SUMMER SEASON







After having to cancel events last year, Wolf Trap is getting ready to welcome people back for its 50th anniversary season at the Feline Center this summer season.

Arvind Manocha, president and CEO of Wolf Trap, says he's feeling so many different emotions—elation, relief, caution—as the calendar gets ready to turn to July and the slate of events commences.

"As we're seeing with many aspects of society opening back up, the first steps are

emotional and sometimes complicated," he says. "There have been so many experiences that were put on hold, and we're starting to enjoy them all again, with all the pent up anticipation that comes with delayed gratification. I can't wait to see people gathered again listening to music."

With that unknown element still somewhat existing, it presented a very challenging job for Manocha and his team to get artists to commit

and plan out a diverse schedule that would appeal to guests of all ages and lovers of different genres of music.

"If you think about how much has changed with regards to pandemic from last fall to this spring, you get a sense of the monumentality of uncertainty we were trying to manage.



"We're typically putting together plans for next season while we're still in the current season—that is, a year in advance," Mano-

cha says. "If you think about how much has changed with regards to pandemic from last fall to this spring, you get a sense of the monumentality of uncertainty we were trying to manage. For live events, it takes time to set them up properly, and this year all of us in the sector have been working on timelines that two years ago we would have said were impossible."

Wolf Trap has long been a place where everyone in the

community feels welcome, and has always strived to create an experience that is easy and accessible, from the picnicking policy to

the lawn seating to bringing artists from all genres to the stage.

"Those ideals were very much part of the season planning, as they always are," Manocha says. "And having something for everyone is always a goal and in my mind, not one you ever fully reach. This year with the short timelines and the fact that the music business is still very much unsettled as to which artists are working and which are taking the summer off, it's a bit more complicated than usual, but striving to have breadth is not just a 50th anniversary value—it will continue next year and years after that."

Still, looking at the summer lineup, which is available at www.wolftrap.org, he's done a stellar job. Artists such as Max Weinberg (July 10-11), Amos Lee (July 21-22), Norm Lewis (July 30-31), Lindsey Sterling (Aug. 5), Harry Connick Jr. (Aug. 19) and Train (Aug. 20) are all set to pay a visit.

"I'm excited for all of them," Manocha says. "The actual 50th anniversary concert, on July 1st, is going to be very special. We are honoring the spirit of Wolf Trap and the legacy of our founder, Catherine Filene Shouse, who was also a fierce champion of the empowerment of women. All four of our guests artists joining the National Sym-

phony that night are women who are titans in the respective fields of music and I think Mrs. Shouse would love the program."

He defines the summer season as being "typical Wolf Trap," with a mix of new and

old, a wide variety of musicians, and a strong sense of community.

"I think people will enjoy everything they've come to love about Wolf Trap, even more so since we've had to put it all on pause for so long," Manocha says. "Mrs. Shouse envisioned her beloved Wolf Trap to be a place where the community

comes together to celebrate the arts. While tastes change and the mix evolves, that original vision continues. The thing about Wolf Trap is the sense of community—which I think given what we've all been through in the last year is both relevant and current—maybe more than ever."

OPERA AND CLASSICAL

It's not just pop and rock artists that people look forward to about Wolf Trap each summer. The site is also known for its amazing operas.

"This summer, WTO is telling stories-

and classical programming. From a forgotten piece by a contemporary of Haydn and Mozart to a 20th century retelling of a story from the Mahabharata, we are looking for universal themes that come from widely different places."

She adds that the pieces Wolf Trap Opera is producing were chosen with specific singers in mind as highlighting the artistry of its singers is a primary focus.

"When we set the initial schedule, we were hoping to do stand-and-sing style concert opera performances for 250 people," Myslewski says. "As things have opened up, the challenge has been to slightly amplify our projects while keeping the various populations (singers, orchestra, chorus, stagehands, costumers, makeup artists) safe and healthy."

A favorite production coming up is "STARias," which will feature a number of

high-profile alums returning to the Filene Center to sing a number of big, powerful scenes from Puccini and Verdi.

"If you're an opera fan, you'll be able to add to your list of rare pieces that you've experienced live," Myslewski says. "If you're new to opera or trying it out for the first time there are a few shorter evening options that you can dip your toe into. And if you love musical theater, try Sweeney Todd—the familiar piece, but with perhaps a different kind of singing than you might be used to."

FOR THE CHILDREN

Another staple of any summer at Wolf Trap is its children's programing, and this year, it's back with a vengeance.

"We have an extremely diverse and exciting lineup of children's artists performing this summer," says Cate Betchold, Wolf Trap's director of internships and community programs.

Among the highlights are Inez Barlatier (July 20), offering stories and songs from Haiti; Grammy winner Joanie Leeds (July 27), whose latest album "All the Ladies" focuses on female empowerment and celebrates influential women of yesterday and today; and Elena Moon Park and Friends' debut performance (July 28), performing her enchanting folk music from East and Southeast Asia.

"The artists that we book are excellent at engaging children of all ages through interactive, high-energy performances," Betchold says. "Whether through call and response or guided movement, there is no lack of audience participation and that makes the experience that much more engaging for the children. It's so important for children to be exposed to the performing arts at a young age because it teaches them to have an understanding of and appreciation for different arts forms and cultures that they might not otherwise experience." *



And, the best part is being able to be with your family and friends bonding on your own schedule!



No matter how much you know about wine, there is always something more to

learn. An excellent way to both experience Virginia's wines and expand your knowledge is to attend a wine tasting. If you're in luck, the owner or winemaker may be present, and they love to talk about their wines!

Whether it's your first visit to a local winery, or you have years and bottles under your belt, here are the most common questions to ask a wine tasting.

What types of grapes were used to make this wine?

Wines can be identified on their label based on the type of grape used. For example, a Chardonnay or Pinot Noir. At other times, winemakers combine a blend of grapes to create an entirely new wine experience. Check the wine notes to see if they identify the varietals, and feel free to ask your server or the winemaker.

It's fun to rely on your own palate to see if you can pick out the earthy or floral notes in a wine, and afterwards refer to the tasting notes.

What should I be tasting with this wine?

It's fun to rely on your own palate to see if you can pick out the earthy or floral notes in a wine, and afterwards refer to the tasting notes. Notice which tastes you experience first, and which come later on the finish. The tastes can change throughout the taste profile. Smell also plays a role and is an important step in the wine tasting process.

Experience the "nose" of the wine prior to tasting.

How was this wine aged?

The aging process can make a big difference in the taste of a wine. Wines may be aged in oak barrels of French or American Oak, or steel tanks. How long a wine has aged and



how long it has been in the bottle can also affect the taste.

In what type of soil does this grape grow well?

Winemakers enjoy talking about the soil and climate conditions that create a great grape and affect the taste of the wine. This is known as the "terroir." No two winemaking regions are the same, even if the vineyards are in close proximity to each other.

What wines are your best sellers?

Certain wines become favorites of visitors and wine club members. Knowing what the most popular wines are lets you see if you agree with the crowd. But make your own opinion. What you like may be different than others.

What wines are you known for?

Wineries may have unique styles of wine, a rare varietal, or a process that makes them different. Ask this question and you may even be treated to a wine they rarely pull out for normal tastings!

What is the story behind this winery?

A number of winery owners never started out to own or run a winery. The stories of their journeys to where they are now are often fascinating.

Types of Wine Tastings

Winery—Learn about a particular winery's choice in grapes, the types of wines they produce. Talk to the winemaker and owners. Tour the winery.

Wine Store—Wine stores offer tastings based on what's new, a theme, a region, or with a representative of a winery or wine distributor. Compare the differences between wines from the same region or explore a new country. Attend each week for a new variety. Ask for wine recommendations.

Professional—Generally held by a wine association or industry. Many wines offered; be prepared to taste hundreds of wines in a short period of time. Focus on the taste. ❖

A staggering one in seven kids between the ages of 10 and 18 will run away, according to a report by the National Conference of State Legislatures. More concerning, it's a spur of the moment decision for more than seventy percent of runaways, reveals the

National Runaway Safeline. For that reason, parents often see little, if any, clue their child might go missing. So, be aware of the causes and signs to watch for and take preventative measures. Also, learn what to do if your child does flee.

Runaway causes

Kids run away for numerous reasons. Many suffer from verbal, physical, or sexual abuse.

Even when the situation isn't abusive, kids who run away often feel neglected and lack financial and emotional support at home. They also may experience frequent conflict with their families.

Other kids who run away may have drug or alcohol addiction problems or are trying to escape the addictions of their own parents. Teen pregnancy puts girls at high risk of running away. Also, lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transexual teens often runaway as a result of family rejection. Foster kids frequently run back to their own families, and

> mentally ill youth are at high risk as well. Finally, some kids run away merely because they don't like their parents' rules.

Signs youth might flee

Warning signs that a kid is planning to flee aren't always present. Even when there are signs, most of these behaviors can be attributed to so many causes, parents often don't realize their child is considering running

away. But there are some telltale signs.

The most obvious is when a teen threatens to do so. While it may be an attempt to manipulate in the heat of an argument, threats should be treated as a serious warning sign. Your adolescent may also start hoarding money, and valuable items might disappear

from the house. You might notice your child keeps a bag or backpack filled with clothes. Your teen may also become more secretive or start staying away from home as much as possible.

Runaway prevention

vide your child with acceptance and unconditional love. Your adolescent should feel loved whether receiving straight 'A's or failing at school. A gay or pregnant teen needs acceptance from family. If your teen has a drug addiction, make sure your adolescent understands while you hate the addiction, you still love him.

Communication is another preventive measure. Show

you care by asking your kids how they're doing or how things are going daily. This can help your child to open up. Make sure your adolescent knows he can talk to you about whatever's going on. Teach him how to speak calmly and express himself clearly – and always respond in kind. Also, ask how you can improve the situation enough so your adolescent will want to stay.

If your child threatens to run away, ask what's going on and why your adolescent wants to leave. Then try to address those concerns. Also, discuss the risks involved with running away. They include:


- homelessness
- the long-term impact of not finishing school
- drug or alcohol problems that often develop
- the high potential for falling victim to human trafficking committing crimes as a means of survival and ultimately landing in jail or prison

What to Do If Your Child Runs Away

- Call your local police and make a report immediately.
- Make reports with your sheriff and state police as well as the police stations in neighboring communities.

- Contact everyone your child knows, including friends, parents of their friends, relatives, coworkers, classmates, and school staff.
- Try to access your child's social media accounts, school locker, and thoroughly search their room for possible clues.
 - Contact their cell phone provider to see who they've recently called.
 - If your teen has a debit or credit card, contact the bank for details of any transactions.
 - Hire a private investigator.
 - Call the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children at 1-800-THE-LOST and the National Runaway Safeline at 800-RUN-AWAY.







Is now a good time to buy a home?

I think a better question to ask is "Is it a good time in my life to buy a house?" buying a home is a huge investment and it is important to not rush into the decision. Interest rates are very low right now which is great for home buyers, but there are other things to consider.

In the DC Metro area the demand for homes has skyrocketed and the supply has not kept up. Sellers are listing their homes priced on the high end and/or buyers are getting in bidding wars and end up paying more than the asking price. This frenzy could stick the winning bidder with a property that may have limited appreciation (or even depreciate) in the future. Another concerning practice I have seen is buyers agreeing to forgo a home inspection in order to create a compelling offer. Waving a home inspection is a gamble, you are buying what

is probably the most expensive asset of your life and you want to make sure that you are not saddling yourself with costly repairs.

Make sure you know what your budget is before starting the home buying process and don't let a bidding war push you past it. Also, be prepared to stay in the home at least five years because it is possible that we will see the market slow down and you will not be able to recoup your purchase price.

We are looking to purchase a new home-how big of a mortgage should we get?

While a mortgage can be an excellent savings vehicle while you are working, borrowing as much as you qualify to borrow may not be a wise financial decision. When you're looking to buy real estate in Northern Virginia, it's especially easy to feel the need to spend more than you can realisti-





cally afford.

It is important to keep in mind that real estate agents and mortgage brokers are not objective financial advisors in the home buying process. Their opinions on what you can afford are likely to skew high, because that's in their best interest. Even family and friends can lead you astray. Your best bet is to have a trusted financial advisor recommend an affordable price range based on your personal situation.

Most lenders use a guideline of 36% of your gross income to arrive at a mortgage payment you can potentially "afford." However, not only should you consider your household income, but take into account all of your expenses, especially any outstanding debts, as well as any future expenses that could affect your ability to afford a large monthly payment. In order to calculate your monthly spending, I suggest starting with your monthly rent payment and add all remaining expenses, such as insurance, utilities, groceries, and any money you put into savings each month. Having a clear picture of your expenses (in addition to your income) will help keep your budget realistic and avoid becoming over-extended. Remember to add estimated taxes, fees, and other expenses to your final mortgage payment so that you're accurately comparing your rental expense to a potential new home expense.

Our house is not big enough for our growing family - what's the best decision financially - remodel, move, or build a new house?

The answer to this question will depend upon your home, your budget, and your needs as each situation is unique. Selling your home to buy a larger one might not be the right choice if you can't possibly make the profit you need in order to the buy the larger house. Sometimes, in high demand neighborhoods, it may be cheaper to build an addition or renovate outdated spaces. Consider making a list of everything you want in a home and circle the wishes that renovation can fulfill. If you've got most of the items circled by the end, move on to the

financial considerations. If not much is circled, you probably need a different house. You may be in a good position to tear down and rebuild your home if the value of your home is two or three times less than the surrounding homes. Keep in mind, rebuilding may be the best option if renovations will cost as much as building a brand new home.

Is real estate a good investment?

Real estate can be a good investment for some people but it is a hands-on investment that can take a lot of work and can be risky. You will have to manage the property or hire a property manager. You will also have to factor in things like insurance, property taxes, and maintenance. All of these costs determine how much money you'll actually net off a rental property in the long run. You are also at the mercy of property values. If you own a rental and the property values in that particular area start to go down, that could affect the local rental market. To stay competitive, you might have to lower your rental rate, which would lower your return. All in all, determining if real estate is the appropriate investment for you requires a review of these factors as well as consideration of the implication it could have on your financial security.❖



Replacing Cracked Third Rail Supports on the the Silver Line's McI ean Station

Testing Emergency Trip System at TPSS#12

t's been a long time coming for residents and businesses along the Route 123/Old Meadow Road area of McLean/Tysons, but road work related to Phase 1 of the Silver Line's McLean Station is wrapping up.

Crews have been working for several years to make improvements to the Old Meadow Road intersection that realign it perfectly with the entrance to the Capital One complex. Finishing touches to the roadway and traffic signalization are just about done, according to Silver Line project officials.

Residents of the area have experienced traffic impacts while this work and other new construction continues in this area. Project officials say they thank the residents for their patience over the years.

The realignment was complicated by multi-

ple utility relocations as well as construction on other neighboring sites. This work was requested by Fairfax County and the Virginia Department of Transportation when the first phase of the Silver Line was built.

The completion comes just months ahead of the opening of the Capital One Center, a 1,600-seat performing arts center that will feature local theater and world-class concert artists. Partners in this project are ArtsFairfax and AMS Global.
